One Man Transport

This model of a one man space transport is designed to be easily built. The model is made up of eight pieces that are glued together to form the completed ship. Start from the front and work backwards, create all the subassemblies and then glue them all together.

A couple of notes about construction:

- 1. This symbol **O**——— represents a reverse fold. You'll find this kind of fold in the engine assembly. This fold needs to fold towards you rather than away from you. This should be evident as you begin to score and fold this assembly.
- 2. You may want to fold up and wedge a small piece of discarded cardstock between the main hull and engine assembly. It's important to keep the top surface level. The wedge should help keep everything level and will eventually be covered up by the intake assembly at the top of the ship.
- 3. Once all the assemblies are glued together, use some watercolors to tint any white cardstock that is exposed. This will go a long way towards making your model look more "solid" and finished. People will never know it was made of paper until they pick it up!
